Recreational Helper

CDBA Ontario runs a number of recreational activities on a monthly basis that promote new experiences and reduce isolation for individuals who are deafblind. Activities may include yoga, music therapy, Zumba, cooking, games, crafts and unique outings. Recreational helpers will support and take direction from the Activity Coordinator. Required skills:

- Comfort speaking with a variety of individuals
- Ability to motivate and animate activities
- Interest in an active lifestyle
- Or you might have special skills that you could offer by leading a special event such as a craft, photography outing, physical activity ... we are always looking for fun and interesting things to do!

Front Desk Volunteer

Be the sunshine that greets all of our guests, consumers and staff at the CDBA Ontario Resource Centre. The front desk volunteer greets and directs individuals, acting as the face of the organization and providing directions within the building. Volunteers in this position also take on administrative duties such as answering the phone and directing calls as needed. This is a key position at the heart of the CDBA Ontario Resource Centre. Required skills:

- Comfort speaking with a variety of individuals
- Good phone manners and strong communication skills
- Excellent ability to problem solve
- A positive attitude

Event Volunteer

Be part of a variety of events that occur throughout the year, including Deafblind Awareness Month activities in June and our annual charity golf tournament in September. Event volunteer duties include helping with setup, greeting, information, cleanup, etc. Required skills:

- Ability to multi-task
- Excellent organizational and communication skills
- Ability to problem-solve in a fast-paced environment
