Re: Sensity Commitment to Continuous Communication

I am writing to you today to provide you with an update on the events that have occurred with CUPE over the last couple of days.

As you know, CUPE represents all Sensity intervenors across the province, in all of our programs.

Earlier this month, CUPE made the decision to request a No Board Report. A No Board Report triggers the countdown to a strike or lockout for all intervenors.

Today the No Board Report was delivered – that means that CUPE members (all Sensity intervenors) will be put in a strike or lockout position effective December 14, 2019. Once again, that includes every intervenor employed by Sensity across the province, in all programs and locations.

Sensity remains committed to resolving all outstanding issues with CUPE and we will be working through this weekend at the bargaining table. We remain committed to reaching a fair agreement for our employees.
