I have good news to share. Intervenors have once again been included among Ontario's essential workers who are eligible to access emergency childcare services.

An expanded list of eligible frontline workers was announced on Saturday, Jan. 9 by Education Minister Stephen Lecce. This expansion helps the parents of school-aged children who may not be able to support their child's learning/care at home because they are performing critical roles, such as Intervenor Services, in their communities and are required to report to work in person.
