Ontario Premier Doug Ford has declared a State of Emergency effective January 14 at 12:01 a.m. until February 11, 2021.

Under this State of Emergency, individuals have been instructed to stay home unless they are essential workers, have medical appointments or they need to go out for items such as medications or groceries.

Given this direction and after careful consideration, we have decided to suspend all family visits with individuals who are receiving Intervenor Services with Sensity effective immediately.

We understand that this will be difficult everyone but the health and well-being of all of the individuals we support, their families and our staff is paramount.

Family visits are suspended during the State of Emergency, Jan. 14 to Feb. 11. We will continue to monitor developments, make any necessary changes accordingly and keep you informed.
