Dear Family Members and Substitute Decision Makers,

I am writing today to inform you that Sensity has in place a vaccination policy that reflects the direction provided to us by the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services (MCCSS). This policy has been put in place so that we can meet our legal obligation to safeguard the health and well-being of all the people in our services as well as all employees. I have attached a copy of the policy to this email should you wish to review it.

I am also writing to inform you that as a result of this policy, there is a possibility your son/daughter/family member may experience a disruption in their services if an employee chooses not to comply with the policy.

In order to maintain the privacy and confidentiality of the health information of our employees, we are unable to disclose the vaccination status of any specific employee. If you have concerns about a non-vaccinated intervenor coming into your home, I ask that you notify Sue Hall, Director of Services, as soon as possible. However, I want to make sure you are aware that requiring that only non-vaccinated staff can work in your home may possibly lead to a disruption of services.
