

Sensity Declares COVID-19 Outbreak in Paris

Jan. 7, 2022: Sensity is declaring an outbreak at its Paris residential location.

Rapid antigen tests were positive for COVID-19, which meets the requirements established by the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services for declaring an outbreak in a congregate care setting.

Individuals we support and Sensity staff are following protocols for isolation. The identities of the people who tested positive are not being disclosed due to the confidential nature of the medical information.

We appreciate concerns for their health and well-being. We are relieved that symptoms have been minor.

All visits to and from the Sensity apartments in Paris have been suspended effective immediately until further notice.

The outbreak has impacted staffing. We appreciate the efforts of staff going above and beyond the call of duty to keep our individuals as safe as possible. The outbreak has created challenging circumstances that are being met with creative solutions to staffing. We are grateful for the flexibility being demonstrated by everyone.

We are thankful also to families who agreed to extend the holiday season visits of their sons and daughters until it is safe for them to return to their Sensity homes.

We are closely monitoring our Paris programs. We will post updates when we have new developments to share.
